



DECLARATION UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION (RTI)

STATUTORY DECLARATION ON RTI ACT

Section 4(1) (b) of RTI Act 2005 covers the statutory declaration of Kabi Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College, Mejia, Bankura. It covers all the rules and regulations which are implemented by the Govt. of India, Govt. of West Bengal, affiliating Universities (The University of Burdwan and Bankura University) and Higher Education, Government of West Bengal.

The College is a purely Government College category and therefore all financial transactions are audited by the Comptroller and Accountant General, Government of West Bengal. The College has different committees to maintain discipline in the campus.


Various types of information related to Admission, Examination, Teaching, Non-teaching staff, Library etc. of the college are supplied from the college within the limitations of RTI Act, 2005.

The members of the RTI Cell hold meeting as and when it becomes necessary in view of making reply to any RTI application.

All the committees of the institution are under Statutory Bodies and come under section 4(1) (b) of RTI Act 2005. The applications under the RTI Act along with a postal order/demand draft for Rs. 10.00 obtained in favour of Principal, Kabi Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College, may be sent to the Officer-in-Charge or handed over in his office. All information about the college under Section 4(1) (b) of RTI Act 2005 is open for the public and can be obtained by a citizen of India.
