About the programme:

Conducting gender sensitization programmes is thus an important step in this regard to fight against gender discrimination and to promote gender sensitive spaces.

Celebrating the International Women’s Day, 2023 the Internal Complaints Committee [I.C.C.] and the Gender Sensitization Committee of Kabi Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College, Mejia, Bankura-722143, W.B. jointly organized a programme on Gender Sensitisation on 29th March, 2023 at 11.30 in the Gallery-1 of their college. 

The workshop highlighted the importance of dismantling gender stereotypes starting with our individual behaviors, and underscores the various ways in which protective and redressal mechanisms at the institutional level can be accessed in times of distress.

Participation:

Spontaneous response was received from students of all the departments, teaching and non-teaching faculties of the college. In total seventy six (76) participants attended the workshop.



Workshop Objective:

This workshop has been designed to get an in-depth understanding of what gender sensitization is, and the basic need for building awareness around gender equality and equity especially among the youth through the discussion on some of our key social judgments on these. The workshop aimed to reevaluate our perceptions and deconstruct gender stereotypes to pave the way towards a gender sensitive environment.

Process of Programme:

The programme was inaugurated by respected Officer-in-Charge, KJRGGDC **Prof. Alope Kumar Das** by lightening the lamp. In his inauguration speech he welcomed all the delegates and dignitaries: Dr. Nandini Jana, Presiding Officer of ICC, KJRGGDC and Associate Professor of History, Durgapur Government College; N.G.O. Member, ICC, Mrs. Sharmila Banerjee, Secretary, *Prattyay*, Asansol; the resource persons- Dr. Debashree Chakraborty, Ms. Rimi Chakraborty and Ms. Gargi Banerjee; Dr. Saubhik Bandyopadhyay, Associate Professor of History, Durgapur Government College, the teaching, non-teaching and student representatives of the Internal Complaints Committee [I.C.C.], members of the Gender Sensitization Committee; the students and all other participants. He appreciated the organizing committee members for this significant initiative and encouraged all the participants especially the students.

The programme was hosted by **Dr. Indrani Hazra**, faculty representative, ICC and Assistant Professor of Bengali, KJRGGDC. She put the opening remarks of the workshop in a reasonable approach.

Dr. Sutista Ghosh, member, Gender Sensitization Committee and Assistant Professor of English, KJRGGDC emphasized, in her address the relevance of the workshop. She talked on the history of the women's revolution and journey of feminism. She also discussed on gender equality and equity in a very lucid way.




Mrs. Sharmila Banerjee, N.G.O. Member, ICC shared her personal work experiences in grass root level both outside and inside a family. She appreciated such initiative as it makes an open platform for students to share their opinions and thoughts regarding gender sensitization. She also assured financial assistance to the needy students for educational purposes (purchase of books) from her NGO.

Dr. Nandini Jana, Presiding Officer of ICC, KJRGGDC introduced all the resource persons to the audiences: a) Dr. Debashree Chakraborty, researcher in Department of Economics, Jadavpur University and an activist; b) Ms. Rimi Chakraborty, teacher at Narayana School, Kolkata and an activist of Women's right and c) Ms. Gargi Banerjee, ex teacher at Vidyanjali International, presently working as an fulltime activist. Prof. Jana briefed the different activities and curriculum of the organization *Shramajibi Nari Mancha* (শ্রমজীবী নারী মঞ্চ). She focused on the prime objective of the workshop, its unique perspectives and expected outcome before inviting the resource persons to conduct the workshop.


The technical session of the workshop was initiated by **Ms. Gargi Banerjee**. She started her presentation by listing the session's objectives. In her presentation she narrated the story of women empowerment since eighteenth century though their history of struggle for basic demands in workplace. She showed some rare picture of women's movements in different continents. She talked in a very simple manner to connect with the audience.

The session was continued by the next speaker **Dr. Debashree Chakraborty**. She emphasized on the stereotype concepts of our society, strict regulations mandatorily imposed on women and men. She briefly explained the purpose and significance of gender sensitization before leading an activity to help us become aware of the many gender preconceptions we hold in our thoughts. The speaker advanced the conversation by describing gender equality and how gender sensitization is necessary for everyone, not just one particular gender. She continued by outlining how we are required to act, speak, dress, groom, and even conduct ourselves depending on the gender to which we have been allocated in India. Her speech moved the audience and they were connected through continuous interaction on different issues of gender equality in our daily life.

Ms. Rimi Chakraborty mesmerized the audience through her open voice and thoughts. She sang the memorable "March of the Women" and made the audience to chant. She focused on the so called do and don't list. She emphasized how stereotyped ideas still remain in our society while outlining the ramifications and benefits of gender equality. She gave us a reality check on how we behave in specific ways that are considered apparent truths and thus are practiced unconsciously. Ms. Chakraborty discussed the connection between masculinity and gender sensitivity as well as the persistence and need for the eradication of gender-based violence. She summarized the session in oath of gender sensitive spaces for all. Students liked her way of approach towards them.

The presentation was continued by an interactive session where students asked questions regarding Gender Sensitization. The technical sessions were followed by a feedback session. Students were spontaneously interacted with the resource persons during this time. **Dr. Saubhik Bandyopadhyay**, Associate Professor of History, Durgapur Government College addressed his views towards gender sensitization through some simple and rational examples. He congratulated organizing members for conducting a meaningful workshop for students. The session was concluded by **Dr. Indrani Hazra**, ICC faculty representative by sharing her views on the topic. Finally in the Valedictory Session ICC faculty representative and Assistant Professor of History **Samim Rahaman Molla**, conveyed the vote of thanks to the audience.

Workshop Outcome:

- Students freely interact with the resource persons. They gathered their courage to share their personal experiences of difficulties inside and outside home since their childhood.
- Some teaching faculties also shared their personal views and opinions in front of audience during the interactive session.
- Students confessed they were to some extent unaware about the stereotype thoughts of themselves and the society regarding gender equality and they want to step forward first individually and then collectively.
- Students cumulatively acknowledged and congratulated the organizing committees for arranging the workshop and appealed for such more awareness programme on various gender issues in future.

Participation:



Respected Sir/Madam,

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC had notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in. These regulations are mandatory for all higher educational institutions in the country.

As multiple mechanisms are required to ensure a ragging-free campus, here are some recommendations and action steps which are required to be deployed in your esteemed university and all institutions under your ambit.

A. Basic Measures:

1. Constitution of anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell and adequate publicity for these measures through various media are to be undertaken.
2. Mention of anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets /brochures shall be ensured.
3. Updating websites of institutions with the complete address and contact details of nodal officers related to anti-ragging committee.
4. In compliance with the UGC Regulations and its 2nd Amendment regarding submission of undertaking by each student and every parent, an online undertaking in every academic year to be submitted.
5. UGC has notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

"3. (i) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background."

6. Installing CCTV cameras at vital points.

B. Counseling and monitoring measures

1. Regular interaction and counseling with the students can detect early signs of ragging and identification of trouble-triggers.
2. Surprise inspection at hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest-cum-recreation rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behaviour/incident shall be undertaken.

C. Creative Dissemination of the idea of ragging-free campus

1. Events like Anti-Ragging workshops, seminars and other creative avenues to spread the idea.
2. Safety and security apps without affecting the privacy of individuals can be creatively deployed.

D. Using other UGC initiated measures

1. Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline **1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free)** or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at helpline@antiragging.in.
2. For any other information regarding ragging, please visit the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & www.antiragging.in and contact UGC monitoring agency i.e. Aman Satya Kachroo Trust on mobile No. 09871170303, 09818400116 (only in case of emergency).
3. UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and UGC has got developed the following entities to promote anti-ragging which are available on UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in.
 - a. UGC has developed 05 TVCs of 30 seconds each from different perspective i.e. Parents, Victim and Offenders.
 - b. UGC has designed and distributed posters amongst Universities/Regulatory Authorities/Councils/IITs/NITs/Other educational institutions for the prominent display.
 - c. UGC has consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty /general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

Any violation of UGC Regulations or failure of institution to take adequate steps to prevent ragging in accordance with these Regulations or failure to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, will attract punitive action under the UGC Act.

You are requested to implement the recommendations communicated vide this office letter of even number dated December 27, 2018 and thereby ensure a ragging-free campus, a fundamental requirement for a supportive and fair institutional climate which is open to change, learning and progress.

In pursuance of 'UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Institutions, 2009', the Anti-ragging Committee and the Flying Squad of Kabi Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College, Mejia, Bankura organized an "**Anti-Ragging Awareness Campaign**" on 12th September, 2019 at 11.30 AM. The programme was conducted in Room No. 207 (Gallery-1). The programme was attended by more than 100 students.

Objective:

The programme had been conducted for alertness of the newly admitted students as well as the senior students (especially those have completed their first academic year in the college). In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in.

It is once again brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism and any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officer's complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands, display Anti Ragging posters at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. The size of posters should be 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behaviour/incident shall be undertaken.

Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-ragging Helpline 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at helpline@antiragging.in. For any other information regarding ragging you may please visit the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & www.antiragging.in and contact UGC monitoring agency i.e. Aman Satya Kachroo Trust on Mobile No. 09871170303, 09818400116 (only in case of emergency).



As you are aware, in pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009" and in compliance of the 2nd Amendment in UGC Regulations, it is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online undertaking each academic year at either of the two designated web sites, namely, **www.antiragging.in** and **www.amanmovement.org**.

As part of UGC's initiative towards reduction of compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging Affidavit.

The revised procedure is as follows:

Step 1: A student will submit his/her details on the same web sites (**www.antiragging.in** and **www.amanmovement.org**) as before; read and confirm that he/she and his/her parents/Guardians have read and understood the regulations on curbing the menace of ragging. He/She will confirm & agree that he/she will not engage in ragging in any form. (Step 1 is the same like before).

Step 2: The student will receive an E MAIL with his/her registration number and a web link. The student will forward the link to the E mail of the Nodal officer in his/her university/college. **(Please note that the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as used to be the case earlier).**

Step 3: The Nodal Officer in the university/college can click on the link of any forwarded e mails that he/she will receive from any student of his/her college to get the list of those students who have submitted Anti Ragging Affidavits/Undertakings in his/her college. The list will be updated every 24 hours.

The Anti-ragging Committee and the Flying Squad of Kabi Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College, Mejia, Bankura organized an “**Anti-Ragging Awareness Campaign**” on **8th September, 2022** for alertness of the newly admitted students of the college (Semester I) as well as for the students of higher semesters (especially who have completed their first academic year in the college). This awareness session was held in Room No. 207 (Gallery-1) at 1 PM. The programme was attended by more than 100 students. As ragging has become a menace, a cause of fear and shock for freshers in the country, it led to new law that curb ragging. The Anti-ragging awareness programme aimed at making students aware of the laws of the country with respect to ragging and how it affects the lives of people victimized by it. The programme was conducted by Dr. Nivedita Chakraborty, Convener of Anti-ragging Committee.

Objective:

- (1) To make the student understand the definition of Ragging
- (2) To provide knowledge on “how to identify ragging activities” and role of anti-ragging squad.
- (3) To provide knowledge on how to file affidavit of anti-ragging on UGC portal.
- (4) To inspire them to cooperate with anti-ragging committee to keep campus ragging free.

About the programme:

The session was chaired by Sri Alope Kumar Das, Officer-in-Charge of the college. He welcomed the students and addressed the importance and necessity of organizing such awareness events in pursuance of the guidelines prescribed by honorable Supreme Court of India and regulations published by UGC. Dr. Aresh Kumar Maji, IQAC Coordinator, started the awareness session by defining ragging as defined in Raghavan Committee Report, 2007. He addressed the ‘UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Institutions, 2009’. Dr. Maji also discussed on different frequently asked questions (FAQ) mentioned and explained within the UGC guidelines. Dr. Chakraborty talked about the history of ragging, incursion and evolution of this evil custom within Indian society, and its evil affects among the young generations. Members of the Anti-ragging Committee and Flying Squad addressed grievance receiving and redressal mechanisms. Students interacted spontaneously with the faculties.
