**KJRGGDC, Mejia [erstwhile Government General Degree College at Mejia (Gopalpur)] was established in the year of 2015, by the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, along with twenty other new Government General Degree Colleges in the state. The College began its journey with the noble vision of propagating quality Higher Education. Initially the college was affiliated to the University of Burdwan. However, since 2017, it is affiliated to the Bankura University and the students are being taught in the three year six-semester Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The College offers the undergraduate courses in all the three basic disciplines- Arts, Science, and Commerce with five subjects as B.A. Honours (Bengali, English, History, Philosophy and Economics) and one subject each in B.Sc. Honours (Geology) and B.Com Honours (Commerce). It is the only institution under the Bankura University, which offers Geology as an Honours subject. All the faculties of this college, apart from their normal duties, are involved in different research activities to improve their own knowledge and academic excellence in accordance with the spirit of higher education. They are always keen to maintain the standard education as well as holding up to the administrative set up of the college. The college is always involved in different community activities such as gender sensitization programme, literacy drive, safe drive-save life and so on for the betterment of society. In Swami Vivekananda's words 'Education is the manifestation of perfection already in man' – our college always strives to fulfil this objective and the faculty members are devoted to the holistic development of the students so as to bring about this. ### Heritage of Our College

Jagadram Roy was one of the Poets of Medieval Bengali Literature and Culture. The poet was born in about 1725 AD in Bhului village under Mejia block of Bankura district of West Bengal. Although the “Saptakanda Ramayana” is commonly used, he composed the “Adbhuta Ramayana” with an eighth stanza (Astamkanda) popularly known as the “Jagadrami Ramayana”. The special feature of this Ramayana in the eighth stanza (Astamkanda) is Sita in the form of Durga slaying Ravana in the form of Mahishasur. Moreover, He is the author of books like “Durga-Pancharatri”, “Atma Bodh” etc. It is noted that in 1743 AD Poet Devi Durga was worshiped as Ashta Nayika Devi Durga, which is still famous in the village of Bhului. Our college was started in 2015 but on 25 May 2017 the college was renamed Kabi Jagadram Roy Govt: General Degree College.

## **A. GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. The college runs 03 (three) academic streams/disciplines - Arts, Science and Commerce – with the capacity to teach major courses in **Bengali, English, History, Philosophy, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Economics and Commerce** for the academic session 2024-2025. Offline classes will be held in the **day** section.
2. The college is affiliated to Bankura University. It offers undergraduate courses under the National Curriculum and Credit Framework (NCCF) of UGC 2022 (as per NEP, 2020) for 4-year undergraduate programme with “UG Degree Programme with Single Major” only will be maintained for academic session 2024-2025. The undergraduate Degree programmes are of either 3 or 4 year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re- entry option with appropriate certificates. The main aim of that system the curriculum is to enhance the capabilities and develop the skill of the students for better employability of the students. **The admitted students must abide by the rules and regulations set up by the Bankura University, available in official website of the Bankura University.**
3. **Submission of Application form does not guarantee enlistment and admission. Only VALID applications will be considered for Merit Lists. Admission procedure will be strictly regulated by the existing rules of the Government of West Bengal and norms of the Bankura University.**
4. Candidates with successful completion certificate of 10+2/ Higher Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Grade) or equivalent stage of education from any recognized Board/Council/University in **2022, 2023 and 2024** are eligible to apply for admission to any of the UG courses.
5. As per the norms of the Bankura University, the candidates who have passed the (10+2) final examination with at least five subjects of 100 marks each are eligible for application. In case wherever only four subjects are offered by any recognized Board/Council etc., for ex. (may be) in H.S or equivalent examination, first language will be doubled to prepare the merit list (similar to the calculation method for best five, mentioned above).

6. Students who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology (with pass marks in Mathematics) equivalent to 10+2 or any other equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts discipline in the First Semester. Those who have passed the same course without having Mathematics in combination or without securing pass marks in Mathematics are eligible for admission to Arts discipline only.

Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to 10+2 or any other equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts discipline.

Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce equivalent to 10+2 or any other equivalent level are eligible for admission to Commerce or Arts discipline.

Students who have passed Vocational Home Science equivalent to 10+2 or any other equivalent level are eligible for admission to Arts discipline only.

7. **Students debarred from any college/institute after accepting Transfer Certificate as a penal measure due to unlawful activities, shortfall of required class attendances (without valid reason) etc. are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply.**

8. **Reservation of seats for EWS, SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B and Differently Abled (DA) candidates will be as per the existing rules of the Government of West Bengal. A certificate in the name of the applicant from the competent authority must be uploaded at the time of online application in the admission portal, and it must be produced during the (physical) verification of documents for claiming such reservation. No applicant will be allowed to acquire the benefit of more than one reservation quota. Candidates having SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B certificate issued by the states other than West Bengal will be treated as General Category during the admission procedure.**

9. The merit list of valid applicants will be published online as per the published Admission Schedule. The Merit Lists will be prepared in the descending order of Merit Index. In case of a tie, precedence will be given to higher subject marks, wherever applicable.



10. A specific period of time will be provided to the applicants for rectification, in case of any system generated error. Such corrections (if any) will be published as indicated by the Admission Schedule.
11. If any candidate, after taking online admission to any of the courses in this college, wants to withdraw/cancel his/her admission, he/she should intimate the college immediately through the mail: [kjrggdemejia@gmail.com](mailto:kjrggdemejia@gmail.com) and [admission.kjrggdc@gmail.com](mailto:admission.kjrggdc@gmail.com). This should be taken as a serious note.
12. Applicants should visit the college website on regular basis to get the updated information and schedule.
13. It is to be noted that any discrepancy/ false declaration/ ineligibility discovered during the physical verification of documents/testimonials of the candidates prior to admission or at a later stage of it shall render the candidature invalid. In such cases, no fees shall be refunded to the candidate.
14. All the stakeholders of this college are must be adhering to the COVID 19 norms/protocols, issued by the Government of West Bengal time to time.



## **B. APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

1. Please read carefully the instructions mentioned above, the eligibility criteria and subject combinations before filling the Application Form.
2. **The applicant must have a valid E-mail ID and Mobile Number (PERSONAL MOBILE NUMBER, preferably the WhatsApp Number). Without these two, applicant will not be allowed to fill up the online application form. Each candidate has to upload photo, signature and the scan copy of the mark sheets of Secondary and Higher Secondary examinations, proof of date of birth, caste certificate (if any), PH Certificate (if any), and EWS Certificate (if any) according to the guideline regarding the size and format mentioned in the form.**
3. As per the Govt. regulation, no fees have to paid for application in National Curriculum and credit framework Credit Framework (NCCF) of UGC 2022 (as per NEP, 2020) for 4 years undergraduate programme with “UG Degree Programme with Single Major” only for academic session 2024-2025.
4. The applicant must keep the hard copy (print out) of the Application Form, after the final submission of online application, and the Challan of payment of Admission Fees after the online counseling and seat booking. Both of the documents are vital for the admission procedure.
5. Eligible candidates can apply only through the official website of this College: <https://kjrggdc.ac.in/> (using the ADMISSION icon).
6. The applicant should follow 04 (four) simple steps/ instructions as given below:

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## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE COURSES 2024-25

Notification number Ref. No. BKU/FCUG/34(A)/2024, dated-23/03/2024

Candidates with successful completion certificate of 10+2/ Higher Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Grade) or equivalent stage of education from any recognized Board/Council/University are eligible to **apply any UG courses in this college**

### Note :

1. The candidates who have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examination in the year 2024, 2023 and 2022 are eligible to apply for admission in this college.
2. **The candidates applying for B.Sc. in Economics must have qualifying marks in Mathematics in 10+2/ Higher Secondary (12<sup>th</sup> Grade) or equivalent stage of education.**
3. **Vocational Courses**
  - a) Students who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology (with pass marks in Mathematics) equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts in the First Semester. Those who have passed without Mathematics or without securing pass marks in Mathematics are eligible for admission to Arts.
  - b) Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts.
  - c) Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Commerce or Arts.
  - d) Students who have passed Vocational Home Science equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Arts.





### Selection Criterion of the Academic Year 2024-25

The applicants for the under graduate courses in this college will be ranked on the basis of the merit index, computed as follows-
