If there is any change in the date of Id-Ul-Fitre, Id-Ud-Zoha, Muharram, Fateha-Dwaz-Daham, Sab-e-Barat depending upon the sighting of the moon, holiday will be declared by a separate order for the date on which the festival would be actually observed in lieu of the date originally notified as holiday for the festival, pending instructions from the appropriate authorities. Sundays are holidays.
