## **Introduction**

## **Objectives**

## **Key Highlights of the Programme**

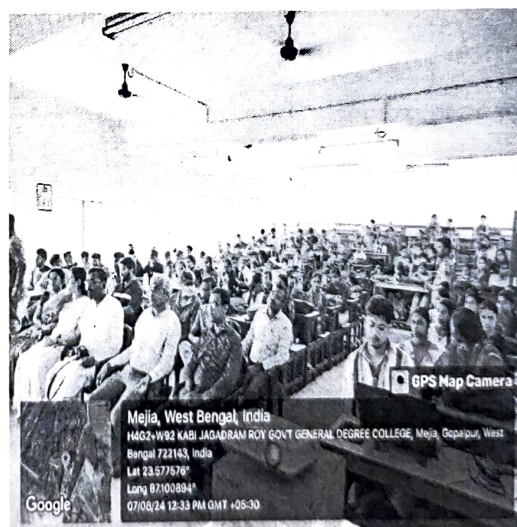
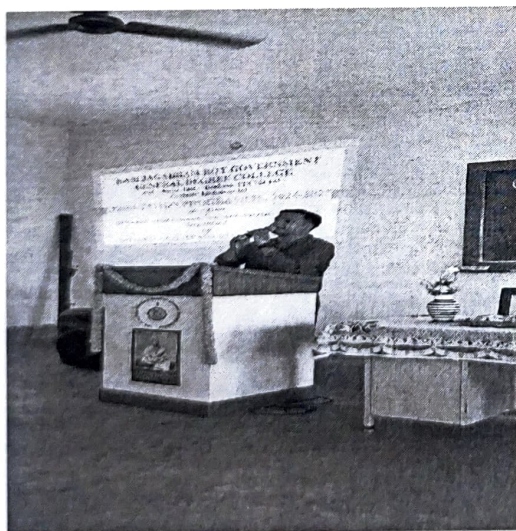
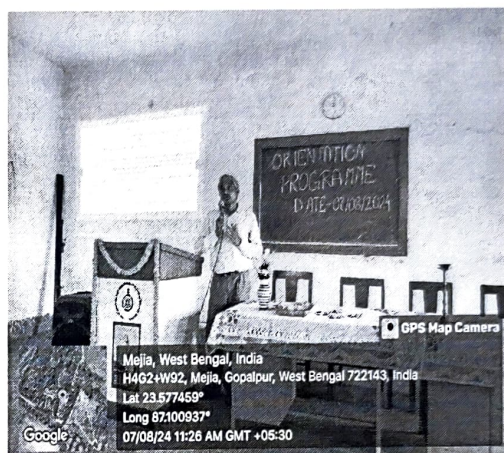
## **Outcome and Impact**
