Introduction

The Internal Complaints Committee (I.C.C.) and Gender Sensitization Committee of Kabi

Jagadram Roy Government General Degree College organized an awareness programme on

07.08.2024 as a part of the Orientation Programme of first semester students to inform the

stakeholders of the college about the functions and procedures of two committees. The

programme aimed to foster a gender-sensitive environment within the college.

Objectives

• To raise awareness about gender equality, diversity, and inclusion.

• To sensitize the stakeholders about sexual harassment and other forms of

discrimination.

• To aware the students about the policies and procedures for addressing complaints.

Key Highlights of the Programme

The programme began with a welcome address by the Co-ordinator of IQAC, Dr. Asesh Kumar

Maji. He emphasized the significance of the Internal Complaints Committee (I.C.C.) and

Gender Sensitization Committee in promoting a gender-sensitive environment within the

college. Then the Convenor of Gender Sensitization Committee, Dr. Rabin Ghosh, delivered a

lecture to inform the audience about the role and activities of the committee. Dr. Indrani Hazra,

the member of ICC mentioned the UGC regulations on ICC. She focused on defining sexual

harassment, discussing its various forms, and outlining the legal framework for addressing such

issues. Participants were encouraged to recognize and report incidents of harassment. The

committee members and the student representative were introduced in the programme. In the

last session there was the opportunity to ask questions and seek clarification for the participants.

Outcome and Impact

As a huge number of students and faculty members were present in the Orientation Programme,

the awareness program was a resounding success. Participants expressed their appreciation for

the informative session and the opportunity to learn more about the process of filing complaint.

Participants gained a deeper understanding of gender-related issues and their impact on the workplace.
