If there is any change in the date of Id-Ul-Fitr, Id-Ud-Zoha, Muharram, Fateha-Dwaz-Daham, Sab-e-Barat depending upon the sighting of the moon, holiday will be declared by a separate order for the date on which the festival would be actually observed in lieu of the day notified as holiday for the festival, pending instructions from the appropriate authorities.
